Reception Daily Schedule

8:55 – 9:05	Drop off and registration
9:05 – 9:20	Whole class phonics carpet session
9:20 – 9:50	Phonics / reading carousel activities, including a guided reading group with the teacher and a focus group with the TA
9:50 – 10:05	Whole class maths carpet session
10:05 – 10:50	Teacher focus activity and independent learning activities with additional adult supporting
10:50 – 11:20	Outdoor learning
11:20 – 12:00	Whole class carpet session – alphabet, days of the week, months of the year (also reinforcing other concepts as necessary) Preparation for lunchtime
12:00 – 13:00	Lunchtime
13:00 – 13:15	Whole class carpet session (2 x literacy, 1 x RE and 2 x other over the week)
13:15 – 14:10	Teacher focus activity, teaching assistant to support independent learning / observations
14:10 – 14:50	Indoor / outdoor learning time – teacher with focus groups
14:50 – 15:00	Tidy up time inside and outside
15:00 – 15:15	End of day carpet session, story time and prayer

Nursery Daily Schedule

8:55 – 9:30	Registration, informal drop off and Carpet section (Literacy, cornerstone or math)
9:30-10:00	A range of learning activities inside and outside. These will be a mixture of independent exploratory learning through play and adult guided activities
10:00-10:15	Carpet section (Literacy, cornerstone or math)
10:15-10:30	Snack time (fruit, milk)
10:30-11:00	Range of learning activities inside and outside – Teacher and Early Years' Educator engaged with focus groups.
11:00-11:15	Carpet section (Literacy, cornerstone or math)
11:15-11:30	Preparing for lunch hygiene and washing
11:30-12:45	Lunchtime followed by outside learning with a carousel of cross curricular activities
12:45-13:00	Story time
13:00-14:45	Opportunity for <u>indoor or outdoor</u> learning with teacher engaging a small group in a focused activity whilst EYE leads independent learning and observations for next steps planning.
14:45-15:00	Tidy up time inside and outside
15:00-15:15	End of day carpet session, coats, and prayer
