We are excited to be planning our **Summer Family BBQ** event for **Friday 12th July** in the school playground and main hall from **4pm to 6pm**. Our PFA will be helping to organise this lovely family event.



As you know, our playground and main hall are quite small: we have taken safety advice so that we know how many tickets we are allowed to sell for the Family BBQ. This means that the maximum capacity for an event in the playground and hall combined is 200 people.

We want everyone to have a lovely time together but also to be safe :)

Children's tickets cost **£2.00**, including admittance, entertainment, one portion of BBQ food (meat or vegetarian), a portion of salad and a soft drink.

Adult tickets cost **£4.00**, including admittance, entertainment, one portion of BBQ food (meat or vegetarian), a portion of salad and a glass of wine or soft drink.

Please make sure you buy your tickets early, to avoid disappointment.

Every week a brilliant piece of children's work is showcased in the school lobby (next to the office). This week's brilliant piece of work is by Khadeeja in Year 6.



Year 6 have been reading the book 'Wonder' by R. J. Palacio and getting to know the story's protagonist: an extraordinary boy called August Pullman. The children have been constructing and writing balanced arguments, exploring viewpoints and evidence on both sides of a debate and offering their recommendations - in response to a tricky dilemma facing August's parents about his attendance at school.
