In English, Year 3 have been reading the fable **The Lion and the Mouse**. Abiheil produced a thoughtful retell of the fable, which was organised clearly into paragraphs, used adjectives and expanded noun phrases effectively to add detail for the reader and included vocabulary taught during 'Word Aware Day' to make the writing more ambitious and precise.
